## The Santa Barbara Humane Society

The Santa Barbara Humane Society just completed its 124th year of service to the people and the animal population of Santa Barbara City and County. Its founding in 1887 makes it one of the three oldest agencies in the state dedicated to animal welfare.

It now occupies a five-acre site midway between Santa Barbara and Goleta, serving both communities with a shelter, animal adoption services, spay/neuter clinic, humane education center, boarding kennels, large animal holding center and corral, inspection and rescue services, and cages for small animals.

Approximately 5,200 members help to support the work. Receipts from memberships, together with gifts and bequests, sustain the continuing program.

The Board of Directors and the Staff look forward to the next year of caring for animals, providing homes for pets and being environmental partners with all creatures.

## Message From The President

Once again it is my pleasure to report to the membership. 2010 was a year of steady progress. We remain financially sound, thanks to the 5200 members who support us as well as the community at large. Our adoption rate for cats and dogs remains high at 90%. Our goal is to help the owner change undesirable behavior so that they will keep their pet rather than turn it in to the Shelter. You will see this program continue to grow.

Beginning in 1993, the Santa Barbara Humane Society led the way locally in adopting out only spayed or neutered dogs, cats, kittens and puppies, a policy that was mirrored since then by changes in state law in 1999. Several of our local cities and the County Board of Supervisors have enacted new ordinances for pet licensing with varying license fees along with veterinary consults for unaltered pets, to meet the needs of companion animals in the community. We do not expect to see the impact of these ordinance changes immediately; in the long-term, it is our hope that these licensing requirements will close the "revolving door" of unaltered animals and their litters coming in to shelters.

On behalf of the Board of Directors, I wish to personally thank the staff, volunteers, and our members for their outstanding efforts and contributions to the success of the Santa Barbara Humane Society. I ask for your continued support throughout this coming year and the years ahead.

## Community Services – Education 2010

### **Humane Education**

The Santa Barbara Humane Society has been giving Humane Education presentations to pre-school and elementary school students since 1949. Our presentations satisfy the California Education Code requirement for teaching kindness toward domestic pets and humane treatment of living creatures.

#### ***School and Community Outreach Program***

The topics addressed in the presentations include pet responsibility, pet safety, endangered species, animal neglect & abuse, pet overpopulation, and the importance of spaying and neutering. Students also learn how to approach a dog for the first time. This lesson includes a chance to practice safely petting a real dog. During the 2009/2010 school year we visited 278 classes, reaching a total of 5,912 students.

#### ***On-Site Educational Opportunities***

A visit to the Santa Barbara Humane Society is an excellent way to learn about all of the services we offer to our members and to the public. During a tour, participants have a chance to see first hand the many wonderful animals we offer for adoption, our boarding facilities and the low-fee spay/neuter and vaccination clinic. Elementary school classes, scouting groups, after-school youth groups, as well as adult clubs and organizations take advantage of this great opportunity which also includes a short presentation tailored specifically to the group.

#### ***Dog obedience***

The Santa Barbara Humane Society sponsors group dog-training classes throughout the year. These classes are limited to eight owners and their dogs and are taught by local dog training companies. We strive to keep the fees for the group classes as affordable as possible.

#### ***Summer Critter Camp***

Again in 2010 we offered weeklong morning summer camp sessions to children between the ages of nine and eleven. In addition to daily field trips to visit the adoption dogs and cats, we had an animal-related "theme of the day" with crafts, videos and games related to that theme.

## ***Technical Animal Rescue and Disaster Preparedness***

This last year was a year of partnering with other animal welfare organizations in disaster planning and preparedness.

**Tim Collins**, our Technical Animal Rescue Specialist, taught numerous hands-on training workshops for our staff and volunteers, including handling of the animals, haltering techniques, cliff rappelling, night rappelling, rope and pulley systems, obstacle courses for horses and handlers, proper loading and unloading of horses in our livestock trailers, and a trailer-maneuvering workshop with an obstacle course at Hearts Adaptive Riding off of Calle Real in Santa Barbara.

We wish to recognize and thank **CMC Rescue, Inc.**, located on Aero Camino in Goleta for their generous donations of numerous pieces of rescue equipment and ropes for use in our technical animal rescue programs. We remain ready, trained, and outfitted with the proper rescue and evacuation equipment, along with volunteer resources, to meet the next challenge.

## Media & Publicity

It is essential that we communicate regularly with our members and with the public. Publicity allows us to remind potential pet owners that they can adopt from an animal shelter rather than buying a pet from a breeder or a store. It is also important to remind people of the safety measures they should take to protect their pets from hot summer temperatures, fireworks, holiday food, etc. Additionally, we need to spread the word regarding our special events and services such as May Open House, June Adopt-a-Cat Month, Summer Critter Camp and October Adopt-a-Dog Month.



We use several media outlets to promote our adoption animals. Some have been featured as "Pet of the Week" in the Santa Barbara News-Press and the Santa Barbara Independent on-line edition. Others have been featured on "Pumpflix", ads running on the gas pumps at several area gas stations. 

## Clinic

Our onsite veterinary clinic continues to be available by appointment to the general public for affordable spays and neuters to meet the ongoing challenge of the pet overpopulation problem in our community. Together, **Drs. Kathlene Barron** and **Tommy Thompson** performed 2,315 spay/neuter surgeries in 2010.

In addition to these services, we continue to provide low-fee vaccination clinics for our members' pets by appointment. We encourage each pet owner to make regular appointments with their private veterinarian for wellness exams, worming, and routine dental cleaning. No vaccination clinic can take the place of individual consultations, one-on-one between you and your veterinarian. They will provide sound advice and treatment when your pet is in need.

On an ongoing basis, **Dr. Barron**, our Veterinary Medical Director, along with our veterinary assistants, **Amanda Weston** and **Leah Blanco**, and our Clinic Manager **Cierra Torrez**, manage all the medical needs of our adoption animals so that adopters receive healthy and happy pets. In addition to the initial health examination upon relinquishment, **Dr. Barron** continues to monitor and treat specific health problems that will make each and every animal even more adoptable once they have been resolved. After a dog or cat has been adopted, our clinic staff provides limited veterinary services for 10 days after adoption to ensure a healthy start in their new home.

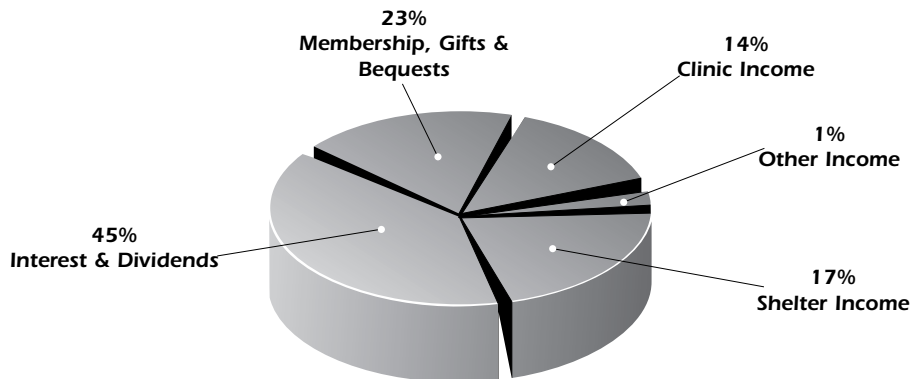

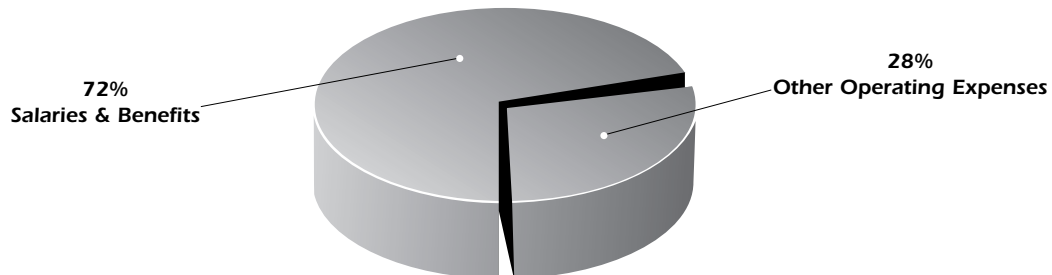
## 2010 Income & Expenses

## **Sources of Income**

The Santa Barbara Humane Society is a non-profit corporation. It receives no tax funds; continuation of its programs depends entirely upon private sources of revenue. Your membership fees, endowments, and bequests are essential to financing its operation.

A portion of operating funds accrues from adoption fees, but these are held to a minimum to encourage adoptions. Some income is derived from boarding of members' pets, and some from donations of visitors, and shelter sales of accessories.

The present sources of income are insufficient to maintain Society activities at their programmed levels. We urge you not only to remit your contribution to the Society at an early date, but to ask friends who presently do not support the Society to become members by donating as their means allow.

The Board has established the Santa Barbara Humane Society Endowment Fund for the purpose of receiving gifts and bequests whose principal will be invested and only the return used for Society expenses and development. This alternative is in addition to the option which now permits the Board to use gifts and bequests to cover shortfalls in operations' income at its discretion. Either form is wisely used and greatly appreciated in our common concern for animals.

If you plan to remember the Society in your will, bear in mind that its corporate title is The Santa Barbara Humane Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals, that it was incorporated in April 1887, and that it has no connection to any similar society. The following "Forms of Devise" are for your convenience.

## **Form of Devise of Real Property**
