

## Level 1 Basic Dog Obedience Training Sessions K-9 Good Citizen Obedience Class

### *What to Expect*

- ✓ The fee for Humane Society Members is \$80 for the class session; an additional \$30.00 in accessories is required to be a participant in the class.
- ✓ The fee for non-Humane Society Members is \$105 for the class session (this includes \$25.00 for a one-year Santa Barbara Humane Society membership); an additional \$30.00 in accessories is required to be a participant in the class.
- ✓ Each class session runs for 6 weeks, each Tuesday evening from 6:30 to 7:30 p.m. The first class only is scheduled to end at 8 p.m. Please be on time so that class sessions end on time.
- ✓ The first night of the class session, you come by yourself, without your dog. This session provides an overview of the training methods and how this particular type of dog behavior training works.
- ✓ Park your vehicle in the back parking lot of the Santa Barbara Humane Society. When you are on Overpass Road, drive past the main driveway of the Santa Barbara Humane Society, around the curve, and you will see the back parking lot gate to enter the parking lot.
- ✓ Prior to the first day of class, all dog owners must present documentation from a veterinarian confirming that all vaccinations are current (Rabies, Distemper-Parvo, and Bordetella).
- ✓ All K9s Behave training accessories must be paid for prior to the first class. These accessories are a class book, clicker, and treat pouch (for a total of \$30.00 as noted above). Additional clickers and treat pouches are available if more than one owner is attending the class. They must be purchased through the Shelter Office. The charge for each additional clicker is \$3.00 and each additional treat pouch is \$7.00.
